You know computers and the internet are powerful tools. They can be used as tools of great evil as we know all too well, where every kind of evil thought and perversion finds an outlet and individuals, homes, and even communities can be torn apart. They can also be used by God as tools of great good, to do awesome and amazing things. A computer is being used to send you this testimony of the work of our Lord Jesus Christ. God used the internet to connect David and Benjamin back in Sept. 2006 in an amazing way. God is using web pages like [newdaycm.org](http://newdaycm.org) to encourage believers and He continues to use it as a tool to take the Gospel throughout the world, even in places that missionaries are not yet permitted to minister freely. We have had people working through our online Bible studies in countries like: China, Taiwan, Pakistan, Nigeria, and Singapore to name a few. In all there have been people from over 30 countries working through the online Bibles studies and using the printable materials. Praise God!

### *New Day Christian Ministry Mogoko*

One of the people that have been steadily working through the Bible studies is a woman named Naomi. She was paying by the minute to be able to study the lessons. She could not afford to stay on long so she would write down the lessons to take home to study and to share. The first time she contacted us we were preparing to go to Uganda and at the time we were \$2000 short of what we needed to go. In her email she asked questions about the lessons and shared how the church there in Nairobi wanted to join our ministry and if in the future we could come to teach and minister to them. At that time she did not yet know we were going to Uganda. With two weeks left we still did not have the funds we needed for the trip to Uganda. We began to look into traveling to Kenya and then on to Uganda. That same week we bought tickets into Nairobi, Kenya at \$1000 less than flying into Uganda and after 30 hrs of travel arrived in Nairobi where 15 of the church members had been waiting hours to receive us and were starting to lose hope that we were truly coming. When we arrived we were deeply moved by their love, humility, and great faith. We stayed in Kenya strengthening them in the Word, handing out the New Testaments we had brought, and organizing the new ministry. We were only able to stay a couple days before going on to Uganda. We returned to Nairobi when the revival was over and stayed with them several more days getting them established. While we were in Africa we were given enough funds to buy them a computer, printer, and everything they needed to be able to share information and print out materials for the church and for the school. ***We will be sharing more about the school later in the newsletter*** New Day Mogoko is made up of 8 different groups throughout Kenya with more than 400 members. We plan to go next year for leadership training conferences with all the groups, vacation Bible schools, and an evangelistic crusade. God is truly doing so much we can't tell it all!

# Uganda Revival 2008

The journey from Nairobi, Kenya to Kampala, Uganda is not for the faint of heart. The word safari is actually the word for travel in Swahili. Well we were defiantly on a safari. The trip took 14 hours one way and was filled with excitement. Imagine going 60 MPH off road in a bus, in the mountains, with the windows open and the occasional dust storm and you're getting close. It is definitely an adventure that is not forgotten quickly especially when you know you will be going back the same way you came. When you could calm down enough to look out the window the view was breath taking. We were happy to finally arrive in Kampala and to be greeted by Brother Benjamin. What a miracle to be face to face with Benjamin after 2 years of prayers and emails shared back and forth across so many miles. We arrived Saturday night and David shared his testimony with the message of a New Day and gave an encouragement to never give up because God is never through with any of us and our work is not done until He takes us home to be with Him in heaven. There was no rehearsal or anything, just right into it, talking about a baptism by fire! The revival started on Monday and was held in a field in the middle of the main square. David and Josh preached from Monday to Friday and then returned to Kenya on Saturday. During the 5 days they were there sharing the Gospel about 40 people came to the Lord but it was only the beginning. The revival went on through the rest of the month.

### Deaf Camp 2008

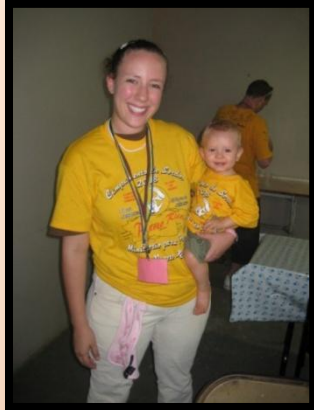

### New Day Child Sponsorship

New Day Christian Ministry now has a child sponsorship program. The children in the sponsorship are children that are members of New Day Christian Ministry Mogoko. New Day Mogoko has a school/orphanage that they started to help these children. There are 37 children and most of them are orphans. Most of their parents have either died of aids or in riots that occurred in 2007 after their elections. During that time many businesses were burned, including the ones that were in front of the church/school. Half of the building was lost to the fire and has not been rebuilt. The children to the left, are Alfonse and Vivivan and their story is the picture below them. These children and others like them need someone to come alongside them and help them as they wait for the New Day God has for them. It is our prayer that you will consider sponsoring 1 or more of the 37 children in our school. Also the church/school is currently behind on their rent and need assistance quickly before they lose the building. 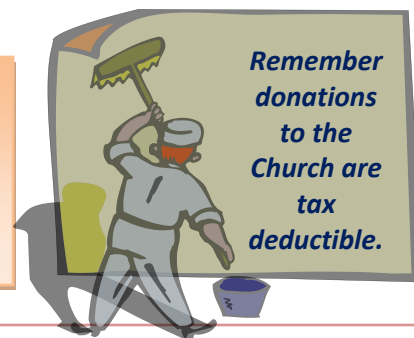
