In our last newsletter I shared that we can be of good cheer because no matter what we may face, our Lord and Savior will always be with us, if we suffer little or greatly in this world, His grace is sufficient for us all. This past year God proved this in our lives many times. There were many things that I could share concerning us or our close family and friends: illnesses, hospital stays, surgeries, my car wreck etc... But the hardest for us personally were all of the losses. From May 2010 to Feb. 2011 I personally said good bye for the last time, this side of glory, to 4 greatly loved and deeply missed family members. Much of the 7 months we spent in the States were a combination of traveling on furlough speaking and sharing with friends like you about the work the Lord is doing through New Day, sitting at the bedside with loved ones who were passing, and attending funerals. Our time in the States was a mixture of joy and deep heart ache. God protected and healed our friends and family members during their illnesses, hospital visits, surgeries and my wreck. We spent quality time with loved ones we have missed and not seen often these past 6 years on the mission field: Also we met many new friends. Although it was very hard to say good bye so many times to so many close family members we also can rejoice knowing that each one died having a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Through it all God has been faithful, full of love, and merciful towards us all.

Since we have returned to the island Hannah and I both have had two left feet, literally. In June I fell down some stairs while carrying a microwave and spent two months recovering. Hannah's fish tank fell and cut her left foot recently. I heard the crash and ran to help her only to slide on the water, injuring my left ankle again. Hannah got her 10 stitches out and although she has a scare she is healed and doing fine. I am walking around fine now as well. We are both still sore but are healing up well. Heather has made it through this past year unscathed although she teases that she prays next time one of us is injured, I will be the one that is spared so that I can be the one taking care of her.

Despite the personal challenges we and our families have faced we have at the same time seen tremendous spiritual victories in our ministry. In this newsletter we will be sharing many of the wonderful things the Lord has been doing in and through New Day Christian Ministry. I pray that the testimony and reports will be an encouragement to you and inspire you to press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

# Now without further ado please allow me to introduce you to Brother Peter Siobe NDCM Kisii branches:

Hello.

May praise, glory, and thanks be to God who dwells in heaven for the wonderful guidance and direction which He has given us to be a part of this wonderful ministry. My name is Peter Siobe. I am the head pastor of New Day Christian Ministry's Kisii branches. My wife Callen Nyabonyi and I married on November 11<sup>th</sup> 2004 and we have been blessed with 3 children.

I thank each of you for your many prayers on behalf of the work of the Gospel, and your prayers for your brothers and sisters here in Kisii, Kenya. I would like to share with you a brief testimony of the ministries here at Kisii.

We started in 2007 in my house with 6 members. Our Sunday services start early in the morning with prayers, and then Sunday school classes followed by the main services. Then at 12:30 P.M. we leave for lunch and return for evening services at 3 P.M. We also meet for Bible studies on Wednesday and Friday. In this direction and fashion while led by the Spirit of the Lord, we were blessed and we received new converts in our ministry. After three months we numbered 24 members. Because my room was very small we decided to look for a place outside under shade. After one year we grew by another 87 members and this church is called NDCM Mochengo. Our main branch currently has over 200 members at this time.

We are located in Kisii, Kenya. Kisii is a highly populated area of Kenya, where there is much poverty and illiteracy. Most people here are unemployed and some make a meager living by peasant farming. We are surrounded by Mormon Church's and Buddhists temples but because of the true teachings of Jesus Christ, people have been moved with NDCM's ministry teachings and have joined us of their own free will.

The Lord has blessed us so much! We now have five ministry branches that we have started since 2009. Our main branch, New Day Christian Ministry Mochengo, has built a new building with a finished roof with the gifts we have received through New Day Christian Ministry. There is still more work needed to finish the inside of our new building and we are hoping God will do it in his own direction and fashion. We thank God for all he has done, even as we meet challenges. Our God helps us so much especially when conducting seminars, crusades and conferences. We are grateful for the support we receive from NDCM which has enabled this ministry to dominate the whole Kisii region.

This month we held a crusade in the midst of Mochengo and Nyamarambe which is now called Kapondo branch. It was started with the family of 12 members and through the crusade 20 new members received Jesus Christ of their own free will. Our God has helped us so much through the lessons and teachings from the website. We were very much blessed to have a network of prayer, teaching, and preaching from all parts of Kenya, especially from fellow NDCM pastors: brother Nicodemus Onserio, David Ogega from Tanzania and Lawrence Nyabuto all came to assist us in the crusade. These men were all a great blessing to the ministry branches here and the community which shows that we are not alone. During this wonderful crusade about 600 people attended and many were healed and received Christ as their personal Savior.

Hello,

I hope you are doing well over there. We are very thankful for the donation we received for food and for rent for the Saika School. Our prayers are for all who donate for the support of our ministry in Kenya. May God multiply their finances 100 times. We have received 86 Kiswahili Bibles from a Good Samaritan. Now, everybody here is able to have a Bible to study in church and at home.

We kindly request your prayers for New Day Christian Ministry Kayole. We have 15 orphans living with us and sometime it's very difficult to have food for them. The Saika School is experiencing the same problem. Every month Kayole school needs to pay \$130 dollars and Saika school needs to pays \$50 for rent. We struggle each month to pay the rent. This past year at the Saika School the vulnerable children were thrown out of their building due to overdue rent which had grown to \$80. We are happy that Saika was able to reopen.

We have 10 pastors from different NDCM churches that come together every Tuesday to have Bible studies using the teaching from the web site of New Day Christian Ministry. More pastors are likely to join the network within the Kayole community next month to uplift the body of Christ together. We are very excited and happy since we will be sharing the word of God together. May God bless you all.

## Ministry Support

As you have read through our newsletter you have had an opportunity to learn a little more about what the Lord has been doing through New Day Christian Ministry. It is not possible for us to share with you everything. We do pray what has been shared will encourage you and challenge your faith to grow. We started out as two people saying, "Here we are Lord, send us." Now, almost 7 years later, this request has grown into a reality far greater than we could have ever imagined. We have traveled further and seen more than we could have dreamed. Today we are still saying "Here we are Lord send us." Through God's grace and mercy many now have joined us as they too are saying, "Here am I Lord, send me," and we are so grateful they have joined us. It has not all been easy, but we never expected it to be. We do not and we cannot do this on our own. We trust the Lord each and every day. Our ministry has expanded far greater than we could have ever dreamed, while at the same time, the financial support we need to pay our month to month bills has dwindled. Sadly we have also seen that many churches are cutting their missionary support from their budgets, affecting several of our missionary friends.

That is why we are so grateful to those of you who have remained faithful, and those who have stepped in and are making sure this work not only continues but continues to grow; whether it is providing food for orphans in our schools in Kenya or distributing Bibles around the world. This is truly God's work and we are very grateful for all that He has been doing. We are very grateful that the Lord has been using many of you to accomplish it. We are praying the Lord will touch the hearts of a few who will partner with us in this coming year as we look forward to all the Lord has prepared.

As this ministry grows so does the monthly needs. We have decided that it would be best from this newsletter moving forward if we share what our monthly needs are and what has been pledged to be given on a monthly basis to support NDCM's work in Puerto Rico, Africa, and around the world. This will not include special donations for projects: Bibles, Church Starts/Crusades, & Construction. Also not included are one time gifts, or the Ingram's personal support & finances.

NDCM Needs \$1,130.00 This is what is necessary to help pay rent for two of our churches and two of our schools. Also included are NDCM's expenses for: Utilities, Transportation, Food, and Communication.

"The support that **NDCM receives** is <u>\$388.00</u> each month. Some of these amounts are the same each month, and others vary from month to month. The \$388.00 represents all of the monthly fixed amounts, plus the average over the last six months of the amounts that vary".

As you can see our monthly ministry needs exceed our monthly commitments. It is often difficult to meet our monthly requirements and we do pray that others will see the value in supporting this work on a monthly basis. Despite the difficulties God is good. Through special gifts and donations we have constructed a new church building, supplied pastors with bikes, reopened our Saika school, fed the orphans, started a new church, held a crusade, and distributed Bibles to our members from our last newsletter until now. Truly the Lord is doing a amazing work and we are grateful to be joining Him and you in it.

If you do not yet support this work we hope that you will pray and seek the Lord's will concerning whether or not it is His desire for you to invest your prayers, time, & financial support in this work.
