### **Malachi 3:8-12**

- 1. What is the difference between a tithe and an offering?
  - a. *Tithe*: A tithe is one-tenth of the annual produce of one's land or one's annual income. It was paid as a tax or contribution to support a church or its clergy.
  - b. *Offering:* The offering is something offered specific like a gift or contri-bution.
- 2. What had the people of God been doing?
- 3. Who owns the tithe?
- 4. What happened as a result of not giving God the entire tithe?
- 5. Who were the people harming by keeping the tithe?
- 6. What did God promise would be the results from giving the tithe and offerings?
